To Whom It May Concern:

This document confirms that as the chief veterinary consultant, I certify that the chickens producing eggs for Eggscellent Eggs™ are reared and maintained under stringent conditions of animal welfare and modern poultry health programs. I have personally examined these flocks on five different occasions, most recently March 2018, and find them to be housed in comfortable, cage free environments conforming to all acceptable methods of modern animal welfare requirements. The birds have adequate space for normal poultry behavior such as dust bathing, perching and socialization, which rivals any aviary facility in the United States or Europe. Additionally, the entire flock is fed by hand four times daily; clean, potable water is provided and monitored 24 hours a day and each bird is individually assessed for health and overall condition daily. Due to the risk of Avian Influenza (bird flu) in southeast Asia from wild birds, the chickens are not allowed to roam outside the aviary but are provided natural green plant material collected on the farm for nutrient supplement.

I have also designed and implemented prophylactic poultry health programs including appropriate vaccinations for common poultry diseases in the country, routine health monitoring, superior feed quality, water sanitation and proper bedding management creating a healthy environment for the laying hens and clean nests for lay and collection of eggs. Current vaccinations include immunizations for H5 and H7 Avian Influenza.

I further certify that the eggs are collected promptly several times daily and are cleaned and handled properly to ensure the freshest and safest egg product possible. After collection, the eggs are immediately placed in a cool area for temporary storage until they are securely transported to the egg processing and packaging area in Siem Reap.

I have served as veterinary consultant for the Eggscellent Farm™ from April 2013 until the present time and certify that the above statements are true and accurate.
